## **February 3, 2014**

The Town Council of the Town of Fowler met in the Town Hall, Fowler, Indiana, on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of February, 2014 at the hour of 6:00 P.M., for a meeting pursuant to call in accordance with the rules of the Council. The meeting was called to order by Linda Brouillette, who presided. On call of the roll the members of the Council were shown to be present or absent as follows:

**PRESENT: Linda Brouillette, Kathy Schwartz, Pat Claire, Steve Rettig, Fred Byers**

**ABSENT: None**

Approval of prior minutes, Pat Claire motioned to approve the prior minutes with Steve Rettig seconding the motion. All in favor and motion carried.

### **Old Business**

Resolution 2013-3 BZA and Plan Commission, Steve Rettig motioned to accept the motion and Kathy Schwartz seconded the motion. All in favor and the motion carried.

Bryan Berry, Benton County Commissioner, and Jason Fisher, Benton County EMS director, were here to talk to the Council regarding the Safety LOIT tax. Bryan asked the Council to consider giving 45% of the tax that Fowler receives back to the County to help with the EMS budget. After much discussion the Council asked Bryan to give them some time to have a work session with Bill Burton and Dennis Rice and then they would get back with him.

### **New Business**

Tyrone Emilson was present to ask the Council to forgive a past due water bill that a previous tenant had left at one of his rental homes. He explained that there has already been a judgment with the Court for the amount. Steve Rettig motioned to not forgive amount with Kathy Schwartz seconding the motion. All in favor and motion carried.

Marc Hansen was here with Utility Supply and presented to the Council the recommended work that should be done to the water tower. He also presented the cost of the contract. The Council asked that he get them a contract so that they may review it and get back with him.

Alan Leuck presented the Council with a letter asking them to draft a letter of violation. The Council asked Alan to talk to Bruce to see if he has a draft letter. They would like some sort of direction on how it should read.

### **Department Head Updates**

Melissa asked the Councils approval to attend the ILMCT institute in Muncie Indiana in March. Council approved.

### **Claims and Adjournment**

Kathy Schwartz motioned to accept all claims, Pat Claire seconded the motion. Motion carried.

With no further business Pat Claire motioned to adjourn with Steve Rettig seconding the motion. Meeting was adjourned.

## **February 11, 2014**

The Town Council of the Town of Fowler met in the Town Hall, Fowler, Indiana, on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2014 at the hour of 5:30 P.M., for a special meeting pursuant to call in accordance with the rules of the Council. The meeting was called to order by Linda Brouillette, who presided. On call of the roll the members of the Council were shown to be present or absent as follows:

**PRESENT: Linda Brouillette, Kathy Schwartz, Pat Claire**

**ABSENT: Steve Rettig and Fred Byers**

### **New Business**

The Town Council met for a special meeting regarding the LOIT tax for Public Safety and Health. Money is currently not budgeted for this year so an additional appropriation would have to be done to spend any of it.

Bill Burton, Fire Chief, stated that he would like to purchase new SCBA's for the fire department. He was going to purchase 4 a year with the town purchasing 2 and the township purchasing the other 2. The cost for each would be \$5000.00 - \$5500.00 per unit. He also stated that he would like to use \$2500.00 to purchase materials and props for fire prevention week.

Dennis Rice, Chief of Police, stated that he had talked with Bill Burton and they would like to purchase a 4 wheel drive truck that could be shared between the fire department and the police department. He handed out a rough estimate on what the cost would be with equipment. The police would use the truck in bad weather and when they have to pick up stray dogs and bicycles. The fire department would use the truck for fires and other emergencies.

Dennis also gave the Council an estimate to equip all 4 cars with mobile data terminals. The estimate included the cost for startup and what it would cost annually. He did let the Council know that he would need to continue checking on the cost of the software.

The Council stated that everything seemed reasonable to them. They also said they would like to purchase the heart monitors for the Benton County EMS with that being their number one priority. The rest of the equipment could be decided at a later date.

Pat Claire motioned and Linda Brouillette seconded the motion to go ahead and do an additional appropriation to purchase the 2 heart monitors for the Benton County EMS after Linda gets a firm quote from Jason Fisher.

The Council also agreed to purchase 6 SCBA's for the Fowler Fire Department this year for a total of \$30,000.00 to \$35,000.00 and to purchase 6 more next year.

### **Adjournment**

With no further business Linda Brouillette motioned to adjourn with Pat Claire seconding the motion. Meeting was adjourned.
