The Town Council of the Town of Fowler met in the Town Hall, Fowler, Indiana, on the 4th day of April, 2016 at the hour of 6:00 P.M., for a meeting pursuant to call in accordance with the rules of the Council. The meeting was called to order by Steve Rettig, who presided. On call of the roll the members of the Council were shown to be present or absent as follows:

Disconnects

No one was present for the disconnect hearing. Pat Claire motioned to proceed with shut offs with Laura Lee seconding the motion. All in favor and motion carried.

Approval of Prior Minutes

Kathy Schwartz motions to approve the minutes from March 21st with Pat Claire seconding the motion. All in favor and motion carried.

New Business

The bid for the snowplow truck was opened. The bid for \$12,701.00 from Kevin Brost was accepted with Pat Claire's motion and Kathy Schwartz's second. All in favor and motion carried.

The Council reviewed a quote from Tanner Utilities for \$4,640.00 to repair the sewer line from the Weist building to 6th street. Kathy Schwartz motioned to move forward with the repair and Laura Lee seconded the motion. All in favor and motion carried.

Department Head Updates

Ryan Whybrew said that we should be receiving the invoice from the aerial mapping soon and he would send Melissa a copy of the agreement.

Alan informed the Council there was a plugged sewer on the north end of town but it has been cleaned out.

Melissa asked the Council for approval to install Invoice Cloud for paperless billing and credit card and check payments online. The Council approved. She also asked to participate in a class that Ronda Conrad would be putting on in April for internal controls. Council approved.

Lyle Garrelts asked if the Town would like to have all of the lights on 5th street replaced at the same time to get them on the same schedule. After some discussion the Council asked Melissa to get a quote before a decision is made.

Claims

Kathy Schwartz motioned to approve the claims with Pat Clair seconding the motion. All in favor and motion carried. It was stated that Dennis needed to sign off on one of the claims for the police department before payment is made.
